
5 Install the Optional Multi-Hopper


2. Prepare the multi-hopper






Save the restraining pins after removing them from the multihopper. They are required if you need to repackage and return the multi-hopper for service.











Load Cards (cont.) Multi-Hopper Printer



- 1. Unlock the multi-hopper lock.
- 2. Slide the lock bar release button (B1) to the left.
- 3. Rotate a lock bar to the left.






Load Cards (cont.)

- 4. Press the cartridge release button at the top of the cartridge and open the cartridge door.
 - 5. Lift the card weight to the top of the cartridge and pull it forward until it locks in position.
 - 6. Load the cards into the cartridge.
 - 7. Close the cartridge door to release the card weight so that it rests on top of the cards.




- 8. Repeat for each input hopper cartridge.
- 9. Return all locks to the locked position when finished.






